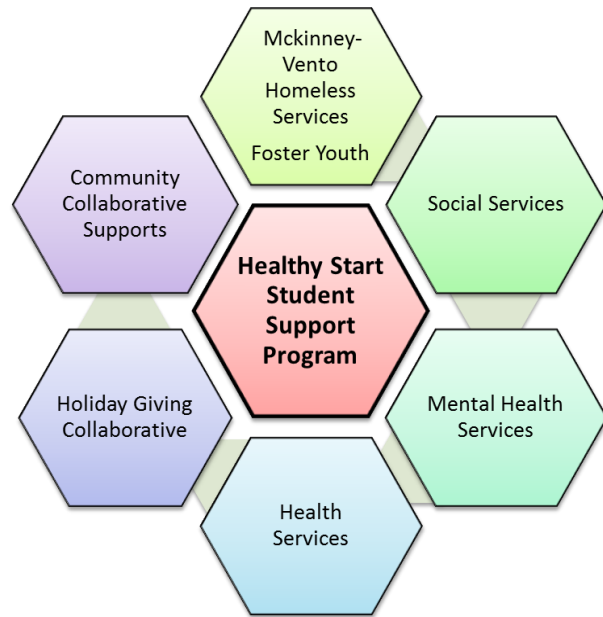
School Based Services
